# **Music Update**

So far this term, Year 1 have been working on their rhythms. They have been playing short four beat phrases, first clapping, then trying them on drums as well as wooden, metal and shaking instruments. Year 2 have started playing the glockenspiel. They have been learning how to correctly hold and use the beaters and have all had a go at playing a C major scale.

This term, KS2 are all starting to learn an instrument. Year 3 have recorder lessons every Thursday. They have now learned the whole of 'Mr Cool!' using all four notes they have mastered. They have even added their own actions. Year 4 are learning a new piece on the Djembe. They have mastered call and response and are also working on playing unison and following visual cues. Year 5 have started learning Panaman and have also successfully played some lovely harmonies on the glockenspiel. Year 6 are writing their own Year 6 Leavers song and are working on some super strumming patterns.
