Issue number: 6 Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2025

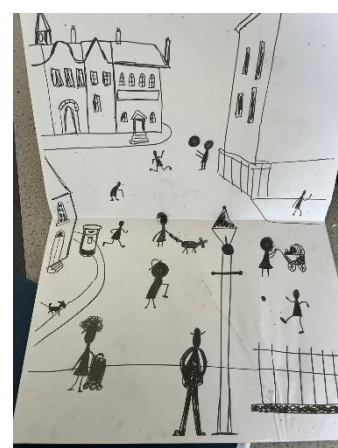
Year 1 tried out wax resist for their Into the Woods topic making some great marks of bird's nests and leaves in their sketchbooks.

## Road Safety Workshop – Years 2 and 3

On Thursday, the children in Year 3 had an incredibly important and practical workshop on Road Safety. The children learnt about the possible dangers of the roads and how to keep themselves safe to prevent these, such as staying away from the curb edge, walking and focusing on the road when crossing, wearing bright clothes and adding reflective elements to their clothing, bikes and scooters. They learnt the four key steps to follow when crossing roads: stop, look, listen and think before crossing.

The children then had the opportunity to practice these skills on Heber Road, crossing at designated crossing areas as well as between two parked cars.





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## Police Workshop for Years 5 & 6 - Being Street smart and staying safe!

We welcomed PC Grant and PCSO Campbell to Heber to talk to our Year 5 and 6 children about how to stay safe, especially as they are now walking to and from school on their own. They discussed strategies on how to keep safe now that the evenings are getting darker. The children always enjoy the visits from PC Grant and ask a lot of questions.







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## Year 4 Horniman Music Trip

Year 4 visited the Horniman Museum to take part in their Sound Around the World Music Workshops. They also got to explore the music gallery and see all of the wonderful instruments on display. As part of their workshop, they had the opportunity to play instruments from Ghana, India and Trinidad and Tobago. They talked about the different sounds they made and learned to play a short rhythm on each instrument. Year 4 listened really nicely and showed great musical knowledge when answering the workshop leader's questions, Miss Grace was very proud!



## Year 5 Geography Trip

This term in Geography, Year 5 have been learning about what it's like to live in The Alps. Last week, we focussed on Innsbruck in Austria, learning about all the leisure activities that residents of the area get up to! There was an amazing array of activities, from mountain biking in the summer, to carving down the slopes in the winter. As part of our Topic, we compared our local area of East Dulwich to Innsbruck by conducting fieldwork down Lordship Lane. Armed with our clipboards, we took part in observational research, noting down how East Dulwich residents enjoy leisure activities. Next week, we will write up our findings!
