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Music Stars

In music this week, Year One listened to different long and short sounding percussion instruments. They then played a rhythmic piece as a class, composing of short and long sounds. Year Two started to learn about different dynamics in music. They listened to instruments being played and tried to work out whether they were being played Forte or Piano.

This term, KS2 are all starting to learn an instrument.

- Year Three are beginning to play the recorder. They learned all about the woodwind family and the basic techniques to correctly hold and blow the recorder. An email is being sent out this week with information on how to purchase the correct recorder for your child.
- Year Four will be learning the Djembe this term. All the children successfully played an open tone and participated in some call and response playing.
- Year Five started learning all about the Steel Pans, their history and cultural significance. They also successfully played a G major scale on Heber's set of beautiful, Jumbie Jam steel pans.
- Year Six are continuing to learn the Ukulele. This week they recapped the basic playing techniques and looked at the C major chord. This term they will be developing their skills, learning more advance chords and strumming patterns.
