


# BFI Maths Trip - Y5/6 Girls



# Year 2 Science classifying and grouping seeds and bulbs

Year 2 had a selection of seeds and bulbs to classify using observation skills with a magnifying glass. They were taught the key features of each, and through careful observation, were able to group seeds together and bulbs together. They did this by which ones had the papery tunic covering (bulbs), and which had tough outer shells (seeds). They learnt about germination occurring when a seed has enough water, and how bulbs allow a plant to grow back every year.
