Year 3 Immersion Day – Rainforests

This week in Year 3 we held our immersion day which was all about the rainforests! We grabbed our rainforest passports and flew off on an adventure learning about the importance of rainforests and all the incredible things rainforests do for us. We tried some foods that grow in the rainforests such as; grapefruit, mango, pineapple and chocolate made from Madagascan cacao beans. We then got creative building our own rainforest dioramas—learning more about the different and unique layers and the plants and animals that can be found there. In the afternoon, we learnt about some of the threats that rainforests are facing and the impact it is having. We shared our ideas on the actions we could take to protect the rainforests with a news report drama activity and designed t-shirts to help raise awareness.
