

## Parents' Evening October 2025

Dear Parents / Carers,

We will shortly be holding our Autumn Term Parents' Evening appointments. These meetings will be used to talk about how your child has settled into their new class and how they are getting on with their learning. It will also give you the opportunity to share any concerns or ask any questions that you may have.

The appointments will be held the week beginning Monday 20th October on the following days:

Class	Parents' Evening days

All other classes	Tuesday 21st and Thursday 23rd October

These meetings will be held in person, at school. Appointments will continue to be 10 minutes long - it is important that this length is adhered to in order to allow the class teacher to see every parent across the two evenings. If you do feel that you need to discuss anything further with the class teacher, please get in touch with the school office who can arrange a further meeting for you. Please also remember that due to teacher workload, we are only able to offer one appointment per child.

Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your appointment time. To minimise the number of people in school, please do not bring your children along if at all possible. If your child does need to accompany you to the appointment, please make sure they are supervised throughout your visit. They must not be unaccompanied around the school building. Playgrounds will be off limits as they will be in use by Magna after school club.

Appointments will be made through your Arbor account and the booking system will go live on Friday 3rd October at 5pm. After this time, please log in to your Arbor account and then on the homepage select the 'Guardian Consultation' icon.

Ms Rich, our SENCO, will be available for informal drop ins during Parents' Evening.

Finally, a reminder that all Enrichment Clubs on Tuesday 21st and Thursday 23rd are cancelled.
