Dear Parents and Carers,

'How do you earn a place in history?' Immersion Day- Monday 12th September

To introduce our new topic 'How do you earn a place in history?', we would like the Year 2 pupils to come to school in roll as a famous person from history for our immersion day.

We would like the children to come to school dressed as a famous person from any era or anywhere around the world (for example: a monarch, an inventor, an activist, an explorer, an artist, a musician) and children will explore their historical character through drama. The first activity is built around children being in role of an actual person from history, so please do not dress up as fictional characters! To encourage them to be in role, please talk about the famous person first and encourage your child to learn some facts about them.

The costume can be as simple or as elaborate as you would like - a t-shirt with a name tag is absolutely fine as long as your child knows who they are in role as!

Children will get to meet a famous explorer and inventor who will set them exciting tasks related to their field of expertise.

Please also bring in a soft toy that would like to be an explorer for the morning.
