Following a successful major bike ride in September (350 miles in 24 hours) he has qualified to ride in the Race Across America 2018, (RAAM2018). Russell told the children that he was inspired to ride for charity following a near fatal episode of a pheochromocytoma three years ago.

Russel is fundraising for two charities, the 'Oxford Hospitals Charity' and 'My Name's Doddie Foundation.' The RAAM2018 is a ride of 3,060 miles in 12 days, that is 255 miles a day to get across the line.
